Meet the following conditions when publishing:

- ✓ The article has been accepted by a journal (that is part of a Max Planck agreement) offering a CC-BY license.
- A Max Planck author must be the corresponding author of the article.
- ✓ The author is affiliated with a Max Planck Institute and publishes under this affiliation.
- ✓ When submitting, a Max Planck email address should be used (if possible) and the Max Planck affiliation should be stated.

Local Funding (FHI Library)

Meet the following conditions when publishing:

- ✓ The article has been accepted by an original open
- access journal offering a CC-BY license.
- ✓ One of the authors is affiliated with the FHI and publishes under this affiliation.
- ✓ The FHI must be stated as the billing address on the invoice.
- ✓ The institute's VAT number must be stated on the invoice.
- * APCs = Article Processing Charges

Other Publishers (Discounts)

• American Chemical Society: The ACS offers a discount to authors at "All ACS Publications" subscribing institutions for the Open Access option (ACS Author Choice) – MP authors can claim this status. Additional discount is possible for ACS members. We recommend choosing the CC-BY license. Please note that additional fees are required.

- PNAS: All MP submitting authors receive a discount for article charges for the Open Access option (\$1,100 instead of \$1,450).
- AAAS / Science: All MP corresponding authors may receive savings of up to 30% on APCs because the Max Planck Society subscribes to the Complete Science Collection. There are additional savings for AAAS members.
